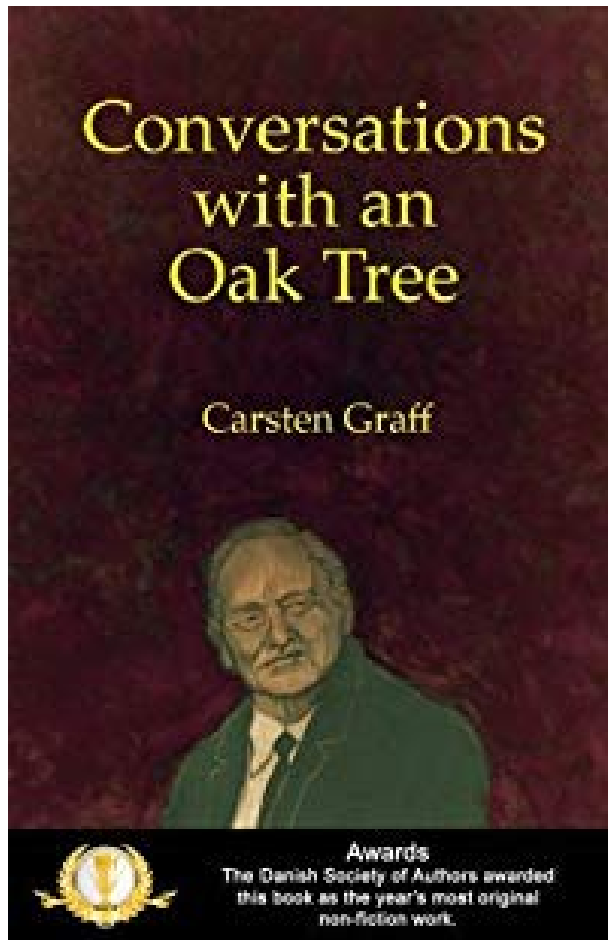

This anti-technology book is a bestseller in Denmark. 10.000 copies were sold to a population of 5 million. In the book a leading computer expert presents the inside story on why computers are not saving time, space, money and paper. It is also a book about the difference between wisdom and knowledge – between development and progress. While entering a conversation with an old wise tree the narrator takes the reader on a journey through the drawbacks of modern media and technology. The book is also available as paperback through Amazon. This is a non-informative book about information talking about something complicated in a very simple way. The book is now in its fifth printing and has made Carsten Graff a popular international speaker.
